### INFORMATION TO NOTE:

-“Change of Major” paperwork should be completed during the quarter you are taking the final pre/prep for major course (typically ECON 10A)

-The Economics and Accounting major requires 3 upper division electives. Electives can be taken during any quarter that you find appropriate, based on course availability. Major electives can be broken down as follows:

1.) 2 electives must be chosen from Area I

**AND**

2.) 1 elective must be chosen from Area E
