<ul> <li>Visit Econ Career Connection to discuss opportunities and have your resume reviewed</li> <li>Utilize resources from UCSB Career Services such as the Vault Accounting Guide</li> <li>Attend any Resume Review Office Hours put on by accounting firms</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Your internship does not have to be in accounting but something accounting- related could lead to smoother transition</li> <li>Give 100% to your internship, Build strong references and relationships</li> <li>Start researching firms and career paths you may be interested in</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Decide what internships you might be interested in and map out their timelines</li> <li>Attend networking events such as Winter Meet the Firms to expand your network and apply for a spot at a Summer Leadership Program (SLP).</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Prepare for an SLP interview by using Career Connection mock interview resources</li> <li>If you don't receive an SLP offer, don't worry. Continue to try to secure an internship for the summer and know you have a better chance in the Fall.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Attend Meet the Firms in the Fall and recruit for an internship</li> <li>Attend all networking events and reach out to any contacts you have made</li> <li>Once you land the internship be sure to reach out and thank anyone who helped you during the process</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Work hard, arrive early and stay late, ask questions, show your enthusiasm</li> <li>Get to know your fellow interns, the people on your team and in your department</li> <li>Use this opportunity to develop professional relationships and find a mentor</li> <li>Full-time offers are extended at the end of the program</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>If you received and accepted a full-time off, then congratulations and keep in contact with your team (quarterly)</li> <li>If you did not receive an internship offer last fall, attend Meet the Firms again. Leverage your connections to secure a full time offer</li> <li>Remember that your first job does not determine the rest of your career – the path to success is not linear!</li> </ul>
