EMPHASIS IN DEMOGRAPHY - 2020-21

Applicants must first be admitted to, or currently enrolled in, a UCSB Ph.D. program participating in the Demography graduate emphasis: Anthropology, Economics, Geography, Global Studies and Sociology. Candidates pursuing the Demography Emphasis must also fulfill the departmental and University requirements related to their degree program.

Demography is an interdisciplinary field in the social sciences that focuses on the study of human populations. Increasingly broad in scope, demography now incorporates research on population health, family structure and gender relations, and human-environment and hormone-behavior interactions, as well as the traditional topics of fertility, mortality, and migration. The goal of this Ph.D. Emphasis is to provide doctoral students in the four core disciplines with the opportunity to gain a broader interdisciplinary understanding of concepts and methods in population-related research, beyond the programs available in their home departments.
